

# **Securden Unified PAM**

## Instructions for upgrading from versions 8.8.0 - 10.8.4

If you are using version 8.8.0 - 10.8.4, please follow the steps mentioned here to upgrade Securden Endpoint Privilege Manager to the latest version.

### Step 1: Take a Backup of the Unified PAM

- Stop **"Securden PAM Service"** from **services.msc** in all the Secondary Servers.
- Stop **"Securden PAM Service"** from **services.msc** in the Primary Server.
- Take a backup copy of the entire Securden installation folder and store it in a secure location.
- If you are using MSSQL as the backend database, connect to SQL Management Studio and take a backup of the Securden database. If something goes wrong with the upgrade, you will be able to restore it using the backup.

#### Step 2: Download the Upgrade Manager

- Download the upgrade manager application from here: <u>Securden-Python-Upgrade-Manager</u>
- Paste the downloaded file in the bin folder of your Securden installation directory
  <Installation-directory>\Privileged\_Account\_Manager\bin

### Step 3: Download and Install the Upgrade Pack

You may download the **upgrade pack (.sum)** available from the <u>release notes page</u>. Once the patch file is downloaded, follow the steps below to upgrade your Securden instance.

- Go to Admin >> Maintenance & Upgrades >> Product Upgrades of the primary server's web interface to verify whether the primary instance is ready for upgrading.
- Once verified, you can follow the upgrade instructions on the web interface.

#### Important

 Instead of executing the file, SecurdenUpgradeManager.exe as mentioned in the web interface, execute "SecurdenPythonUpgradeManager.exe".
 You may follow the other steps as mentioned in the interface.
